DAY 1: ARTISTIC IMMERSION AND ICONIC VIEWS

09:30 - 13:00 · Louvre Museum

14:30 - 16:30 · Eiffel Tower

Built by King Louis IX, the chapel was intended to house precious Christian relics. The upper chapel, in particular, is a masterpiece of Gothic architecture, with its walls almost entirely composed of glass.

Prepare to be mesmerized by the sheer scale and artistry of the stained glass, which tells stories from the Old and New Testaments. The effect is particularly stunning on a sunny day.
